The project requirements called for weatherproof NEMA rated equipment enclosures that could provide security as well as heating and cooling options to protect valuable surveillance and communications equipment.

Solution

L-com was able to offer several different versions of its off-the-shelf weatherproof NEMA enclosures to meet SECOVI's system requirements. L-com positioned its NB181608-10F, NB181608-10FS and NB181608-1HFS equipment enclosures providing secure, rugged housing for the video surveillance equipment. SECOVI installed over 900 surveillance monitoring points using L-com's weatherproof enclosures providing around the clock video surveillance.
